Southeastern CU's 2017-2018 Student Advisory Board will hold nine meetings. If selected as a participant, you will be required to attend at least seven meetings total, two of which MUST be the first and last meetings. If you cannot fulfill this obligation, please do not submit an application as you may take this opportunity away from another student. Meetings are generally held the second Tuesday of the month after school. Tentative dates of the 2017-2018 meetings are as follows: Tuesday, September 12; Tuesday, October 10; Tuesday, November 14; Tuesday, December 12; Tuesday, January 9; Tuesday, February 13; Tuesday, March 13; Tuesday, April 10; May - Date/time TBA. Meetings start at 4 pm and end no later than 5:30 pm, unless announced otherwise. You should arrive 10-15 minutes early to each meeting and stay for the duration of the meeting. You must be a high school senior as of September 2015 in a school in Ben Hill, Berrien, Brooks, Cook, Echols, Irwin, Lanier, Lowndes, Tift or Turner County and be able to provide your own transportation to and from meetings. The first meeting (September 12) will be held at Southeastern Headquarters located at 3501 N. Valdosta Road in Valdosta, GA. Future meeting locations will be announced at the meeting prior. All future meetings will be held at a location in Valdosta, GA TBA. If you are under the age of 18, your transportation to and from meetings must be parent-approved. Students and parents must also agree to and sign the Media Release Form inserted with this application packet, as well as the Extracurricular Release form. If selected as a participant, you may be required to sign additional waivers as-needed. At the end of the term, if all requirements have been met, each participant will receive a \$500 scholarship from the Credit Union. All applications may be submitted in person at any Southeastern Credit Union branch, via mail to the Attn: Brandy Wilkes PO Box 2067 Valdosta, GA 31604. The applications must be received by Friday, April 28, 2017.

It is expected of all participants to be proactive in participating in board events during the term.
